| Crop | Pest | Rate | Critical Comments |

| Banana (North Queensland only) | Banana rust thrips (<i>Chaetanaphothrips signipennis</i>) | 1 bag per bunch | Apply bag to bunch. Tie on after the flower bracts have fallen from the bunch, which is usually around 2 weeks after bell emergence. A registered bell injection treatment must be applied at the appropriate timing to minimise damage before the Starbunch Banana Bag is applied. Choose a product with a mode of action other than a group 3A Insecticide as a part of a best practice resistance management plan. Remove bags from bunch at harvest time and collect for provision back to FMC Australasia Pty Ltd. |

Some naturally occurring insect biotypes resistant to Starbunch and other Group 3A insecticides may exist through normal genetic variability in any insect population. The resistant individuals can eventually dominate the insect population if Starbunch or other Group 3A insecticides are used repeatedly. The effectiveness of Starbunch on resistant individuals could be significantly reduced. Since occurrence of resistant individuals is difficult to detect prior to use, FMC Australasia Pty Ltd accepts no liability for any losses that may result from the failure of Starbunch to control resistant insects.

PRECAUTIONS

Do not use to package or store food.

If no landfill or approved disposal site is available, bury bags and wrapping below 500 mm in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose clear of waterways, desirable vegetation and tree roots, in compliance with relevant Local, State or Territory government regulations. Empty containers and product should not be burnt.
