GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

FMC Wetter 1000 is a non-ionic surfactant and is suitable for use with all types of herbicides, insecticides and fungicides. It is suitable for application from properly calibrated boom sprayers, misting machines, aircraft and knapsacks.

Thorough coverage is essential, but care should be taken to ensure run-off does not occur when using hand held equipment or knapsacks

COMPATIBILITY

FMC Wetter 1000 may be used with all products where the addition of a non-ionic surfactant or wetting agent is recommended.

MIXING

FMC Wetter 1000 mixes easily with water and should be added directly to the spray tank. It should not be added to undiluted sprays, concentrates or chemicals containing wetting agents.

PROTECTION OF WILDLIFE, FISH, CRUSTACEANS AND ENVIRONMENT

Do not contaminate streams, rivers or waterways with the chemical or used container.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep out of reach of children. Store in the closed, original container in a well ventilated area out of direct sunlight.

DO NOT re-use container. Triple or preferably pressure rinse containers before disposal. Add rinsings to spray tank. Do not dispose of undiluted chemicals on site. If recycling, replace cap and return clean container to recycler or designated collection point. If not recycling, break, crush or puncture and bury empty containers in a local authority landfill. If no landfill is available, bury the containers below 500mm in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose clear of waterways, desirable vegetation and tree roots. Empty containers and product should not be burnt.

SAFETY DIRECTIONS

Avoid contact with eyes and skin. When using this product wear rubber/PVC gloves, goggles and overalls. If product gets on skin wash area thoroughly. Always following the precautionary statements on the label of the pesticide(s) that are to be used with FMC Wetter 1000.
