- I currently work or study in the agriculture industry
- I am aged between 18-35
- I am a individual application and not applying as a team
- As a consideration of my entry into this Program, I grant FMC the 'non-exclusive' rights to publish material generated from my involvement in the Program and from the outcomes of the bursary. Including but not limited to: Photographs and videos of myself in its publicity material to promote the FMC LEAD Program.
