Some naturally occurring insect biotypes resistant to Starbunch® and other Group 3A insecticides may exist through normal genetic variability in any insect population. The resistant individuals can eventually dominate the insect population if Starbunch® or other Group 3A insecticides are used repeatedly. The effectiveness of Starbunch® on resistant individuals could be significantly reduced. Since occurrence of resistant individuals is difficult to detect prior to use, FMC Australasia Pty Ltd accepts no liability for any losses that may result from the failure of Starbunch® to control resistant insects.

PRECAUTIONS

DO NOT use to package or store food.
